



## The Basic Idea:

Libertarian/YJW Student groups, and local LP affiliates that are partnering with said groups, will table at college campuses and encourage people to register or change their registration (hence the “RE” register) to Libertarian.

These groups will receive literature (similar to the ones found on LPstore: <https://lpstore.org/product/what-is-the-lp-rack-card/>), links to their states voter registration form and online registration, and possibly banners, stickers and signs for the tables.

This will be coupled with a national social media effort, and support from the national party.

## Participating Groups Will Provide:

- pens
- clipboards
- folding tables
- voter registration forms (or electronic means of filing), though instructions will be provided on how to obtain them in this form.
