Who we are:

The LYC was founded at the Libertarian Party of Pennsylvania March 2016 Convention. The mission of the LYC is "Promoting the restructuring of the party and its policy to promote outreach and membership of younger voters within the Libertarian Party." We have taken it upon ourselves to not wait for the Libertarian Party to do this; on the contrary we are working to establish Caucuses at high schools and colleges across the nation. We hope the LNC will recognize and support our efforts.

What we have done:

We have started over 10 Caucuses so far. The LYC helped the social media of about a dozen down-ticket races during the 2016 race, and produced and paid for hundreds of voting guides for Western Pennsylvania voters. We also designed and distributed specialty yard signs for the Greater Pittsburgh for Gary Johnson campaign. So far, the LYC has produced 3 commercials and 2 instructional videos for the Libertarian Party (at no cost to them), racking up around 35,000 views on social media. We hope to partner with the Libertarian Leadership academy to produce training on youth outreach, and how to start campus organizations.

Contacts for States and Regions:

The LYC has tried to form regions closely resembling LNC Regions. So far, The Southeastern Region, New England Region, Western Region, Oregon, and Southcentral Regions have been
