

1 ARTICLE 4: MEMBERSHIP

- 2 1. Members of the Party shall be those persons who have certified in writing that they oppose the
3 initiation of force to achieve political or social goals and are eligible to vote in any federal
4 election within the United States of America. No additional criteria shall be required of
5 members.
- 6 2. The National Committee may offer life memberships, and must honor all prior and future life
7 memberships.
- 8 3. The National Committee may create other levels of membership and shall determine the
9 contribution or dues levels for such memberships.
- 10 4. "Sustaining members" are members of the Party who:
- 11 a. During the prior twelve months have donated, or have had donated on their behalf, an
12 amount of at least \$25; or
- 13 b. Are Life members.
- 14 5. Memberships is perpetual and shall not be removed except in the following instances:
- 15 a. The member indicates in writing they are no longer a member of the Party,
16 b. The member has become inactive after a period of ten years,
17 c. The member does not meet the qualifications in section 1 of this article, or
18 d. The member is deceased.
- 19 6. The Judicial Committee shall retain the sole right to review membership questions, and the
20 power to remove memberships.
